**SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**SEASON HOURS 10:00AM – 10:00PM**

The following rules and regulations are for the protection and benefit of and to assure the safe and sanitary operation of the pool and facilities. Your cooperation in abiding by these rules will ensure a pleasant relaxation and recreation for all concerned. Residents are required to caution their guests to observe all rules and regulations and obey the instructions of the Management.

Failure to comply with these rules shall be considered sufficient cause for any action deemed necessary by the management including the barring of violators from the use of the pool area.

1. Any person not on the Royal Arms Apartments lease is a guest and must be accompanied at all times by an adult resident (a person 18 years of age or older). Residents, please limit your guests-never more than 2 guests per apartment. Do not give anyone permission to use the pool if you are not with them. If you have more than 2 guests, check with the management. \*\*\*\*This rule is subject to change if overcrowded conditions occur.\*\*\*\*
2. Resident I.D. cards must accompany all residents entering the pool.
3. No children under the age of 14 allowed in the pool area unless accompanied by an adult. If the child is 14 or over, they must be able to swim in order to come to the pool alone. Make sure your children know the rules and regulations of the pool and the importance of abiding by these rules.
4. No food, bottles or glass allowed inside the pool enclosure. You may use non-breakable containers, such as thermos glasses, paper or plastic cups. Alcohol is not allowed in the pool area.
5. Proper swimsuits must be worn in the pool. Cut-off jeans and thongs are not allowed. Bobby pins, clips, and hair apparel are not to be worn in the pool.
6. All persons entering the pool should be as clean as possible. No persons deeply covered with suntan lotion or bath oil are allowed in the pool.
7. No roughhousing or running is allowed in or around the pool.
8. For personal health, it is required that no person who has an infectious or communicable disease enter the pool. Admission shall be refused to anyone with skin abrasions, colds/cough, infections or wearing bandages.
9. Radios may be played provided the volume is kept so low so as not to disturb others.
10. The management is not responsible for any injuries that may occur at any time within the pool area, and assume no liability for articles left in the pool area.
11. The pool may be closed at any time due to either breakdown or other operation difficulties and/or at the discretion of the manager. Jumping the fence when the gate is locked will result in the suspension of pool privileges of all violators involved.
12. No abusive language will be tolerated.
13. Children who are not toilet trained and anyone who is incontinent must wear waterproof pants.
14. No pets are allowed in the enclosed pool area or patio area, with the understanding the guide, service and companion animals are not "pets." Do not tie pets to outside the pool area while you visit or swim.
15. All trash, cigarette butts, matches, etc. must be put in the containers placed in the pool area. Please help us keep our pool clean.
16. The management reserves the right to refuse entry or to deny pool privileges to anyone at its sole discretion. If you are a resident, the rules and regulations are a part of your lease.
17. Do not play on or unhook the safety rope. The Health Dept. will close the pool for 3 days if this happens.
18. Floats and inflatable toys are allowed in the pool but only when the pool area is not crowded.
19. All safety equipment must be left in place at all times. This is emergency equipment and is not to be played with.
20. No bicycles, tricycles, skates or skateboards are allowed in the pool area.

These rules may be revised or additional rules established at any time by the management. I/We have read the above rules and agree to abide by all rules covering the operation and use of the pool.
